COUNCIL MEETING OF DECEMBER 3, 1968

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Charles Kemler, Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl and Lester Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, John Murray, City Attorney and Farris Roberts, Marilyn Johnson, Ruth Crocker and George Klinkenberg of Planning Commission, Bruce Browne, Engineer and Fred Sterner.

Minutes of November 12, 1968 meeting was read and approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Kemler moved and seconded by Worley to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Raines moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to withhold 10% of amount due Joe Jauernig for oiling streets until street between Jr. High and Grade school is redone. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer suggested and all councilmen concurred that the following resolution be prepared: Be it resolved the City of Basehor request ~~Leavenworth~~ County Engineer of Leavenworth County, Kansas to repair and resurface streets of the City of Basehor to the extent of funds available during spring and summer of 1969.

Kemler moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to pay expenses of Cecil Swope, Meals & Lodging, if he can attend Police Seminar at Great Bend, Kansas. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Planning commission group requested enactment of Building, Electrical and Plumbing codes. City Attorney to secure copies of same for next council meeting. Planning commission to number houses in Basehor.

Progress report on sewers - half done on field work. Aerial photography next week. Preliminary plans to be submitted this month to State and to Metropolitan Planning for review. Plans to be done by end of January 1969. Mr. Browne explained boundary changes and assessment procedure.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
