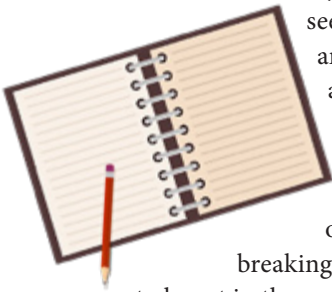

## Basehor Brush Dump

Summertime yard cleanup can be a lot of work! Did you know the Basehor Municipal Services Department accepts yard waste and tree branches at their facility located at 2300 North 158th Street?



Yard waste and tree branches are accepted Monday-Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and on the second Saturday of each month from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm at the brush site location. Yard waste can also be included weekly within your 96-gallon trash cart. You can put yard waste in your trash cart but once the trash cart is full, the separate bags of trash or yard waste outside of your cart will require an overage sticker. The overage stickers can be purchased for \$1.25 each at Basehor City Hall 2620 N. 155th St. Monday -Friday 8:00 am – 4:30 pm.

## 2023 Budget

It's budget season! City staff and elected officials have been working hard to craft the City of Basehor 2023 budget that delivers quality services without increasing the City's mill rate. A few highlights of the budget include three additional staff members, resources dedicated to economic development, and funding for road repair and improvements. We are happy to report that the proposed budget maintains a flat mill rate of 33.868 mills.



In accordance with State Statute, the City will hold two public hearings on the proposed 2023 budget. These hearings are scheduled for August 24th at 7:00 PM and 7:15 PM. The topics of the hearings are the proposed 2023 budget and the City's intent to exceed the revenue neutral rate. Both hearings will be noticed in the Leavenworth Times as well on the City's Facebook page and eNews.

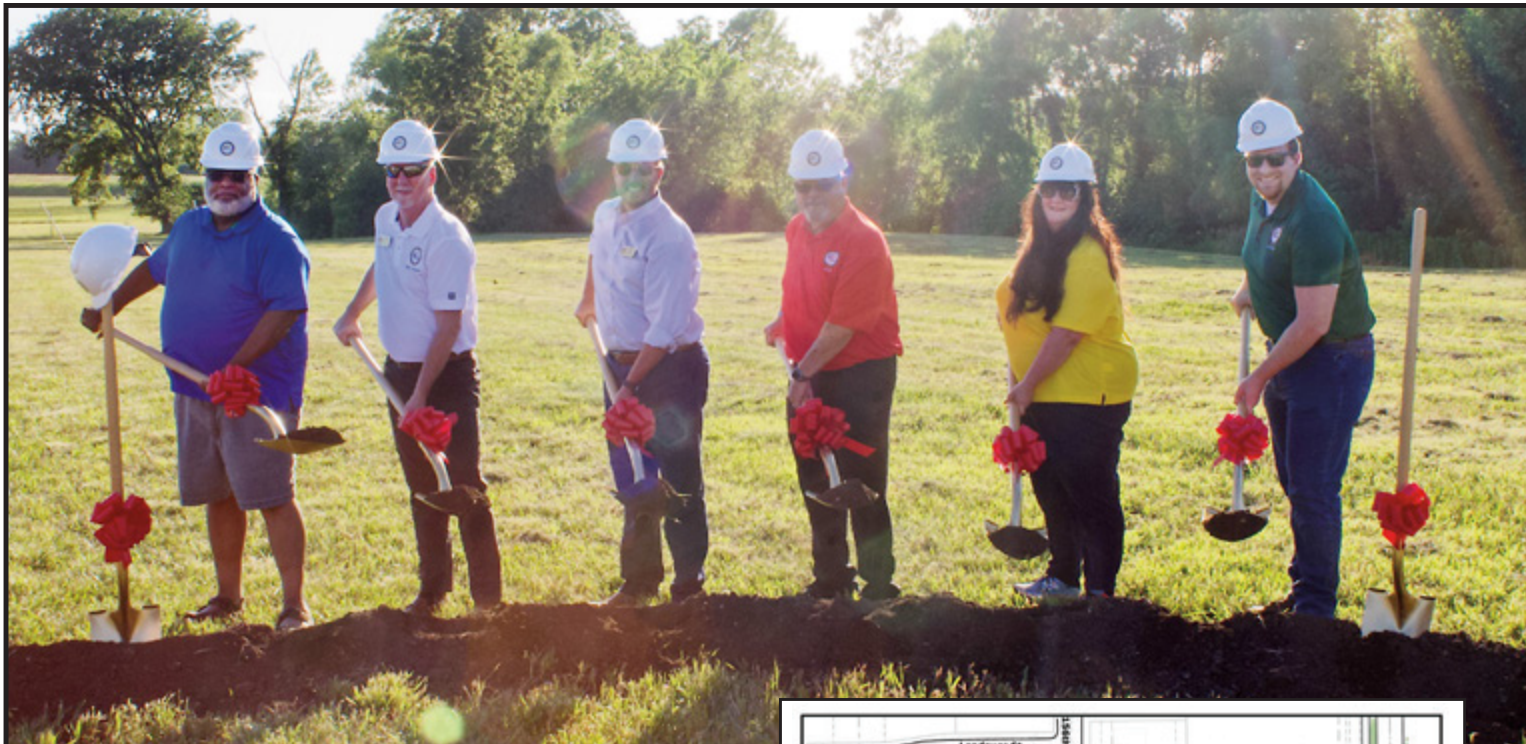


The crime statistics displayed in the graphic are for the second quarter in 2022.

## Tomahawk Park Phase I Groundbreaking Ceremony

On June 29, 2022, the City of Basehor hosted the Groundbreaking Ceremony for Tomahawk Park Phase I. In the two most recent surveys we have done in our community, the message has been loud and clear: our residents want more parks and more trails. This Governing Body has listened closely to our residents and what an honor it is to be delivering on those promises.

Tomahawk Park is a total of 12 acres of land. Phase I will feature a playground, internal trail loop, and open green space. In Phase II, we will construct a parking lot, restroom facilities, and a park shelter. The 12 acres of land for Tomahawk Park was donated to the City of Basehor by Steve and Darla Miles. Thank you to Steve and Darla for their incredibly generous donation to make this park possible.

Once Tomahawk Park is fully constructed, it will connect to the improvements planned for 155th St and the pedestrian and bicycle improvements on 158th St.

City staff worked closely with the students from Basehor Intermediate School on this project. These students were an incredibly important part in designing the playground for Tomahawk Park. The students took an electronic survey and gave feedback to our landscape architect and City staff about what they wanted in the playground. After giving feedback to the staff, these students also presented to the City Council about their findings and what was important for them to see in the park.

Phase I of the Tomahawk Park will be completed by the end of November 2022. Phase II is expected to be completed in 2024.
