Expungement Rules

Upon receipt of the petition and filing fee:

1. The court will order a date for hearing and include a notice to the Court, City Prosecutor and Police Department.
2. The Court Clerk, within thirty (30) days after the date of the of the filing of petition, shall conduct a post-sentencing investigation and place all supporting documentation, along with the order in the expungement folder for review by the City Prosecutor.
3. On the date of the hearing, the City Prosecutor will inform the Judge and you of any findings from the post-sentencing investigation.

If the City Prosecutor finds any reason not to proceed with the expungement, you will be given the opportunity to review the supporting documents and address the findings.

4. The Judge will have the final decision as to granting or denying the order.
5. If the expungement is granted, the order shall, in addition to the information required by K.S.A. 12-4516, contain a direction to the Clerk to send certified copies of the order to the Kansas Bureau of Investigation.
