






## CITY POPULATION GROWTH 2010-2020





# COMMUNITY INPUT

## *City of Basehor* Progress Report



### **New Sidewalks and Trail Connections**



The City has since added more than 3 miles of sidewalks, walking trails, and multi-use paths to offer community members safe mobility options.

### **Walking and Bike Trails**



The City's new MetroGreen Trail recently opened that includes one mile of trail that is ten feet wide to accommodate the community.

### **Streets**



The City completed \$2.4 million in road improvements to 5 neighborhoods in addition to 155th St improvements, totaling over \$17 million in improvements.

### **Park Amenities**



The City opened Tomahawk Park in March 2023 and then the Basehor Civic Campus amenities in August 2024, including a Splash Pad and Playground.

### **Cleanup of Litter and Debris**




The City's new Codes Enforcement Program Coordinator has resolved more than 400 code enforcement cases since Spring of 2024.
